ROUTES THROUGH CARE

primary CARE

Primary care services are normally the first places you will contact about your health. For example, your GP practice.

secondary CARE

If you need more treatment or care than you are able to get from primary care, then you will be sent on to a secondary care service. For example, a cardiologist, who will care for your heart health.

HIV SERVICES

HIV specialist services ensure you are receiving the right HIV treatment for you, and that you are keeping well.

charity and peer support SERVICES

Outside of the NHS, charities and peer support services can provide additional information to help you live well with HIV.
