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primary CARE

Primary care services are normally the first places you will contact about your health. For example, your GP practice.

secondary CARE

If you need more treatment or care than you are able to get from primary care, then you will be sent on to a secondary care service. For example, a cardiologist, who will care for your heart health,

HIV specialist services

HIV specialist services ensure you are receiving the right HIV treatment for you, and that you are keeping well.

charity sector services AND PEER SUPPORT

Outside of the HSE, charities and peer support can provide additional services and information to help you live well with HIV.
